Kailash Pilgrimage Tour in Tibet

Mount Kailash is the holiest of all the holy mountains. The spiritual junction for both the Hindus and Buddhists is situated in the western part of Tibet. The pilgrimage tour to Mt. Kailash and Lake Mansarovar is a journey into a remote and secluded land where one seems to leave behind one's material attachments as they travel towards the holy lake. On this Kailash Mansarovar pilgrimage tours and treks.

We take a scenic drive onto the lush vegetation of conifer, rhododendron and oak trees via the semi deserted windswept landscape to the highest plateau in the world. You can see the numbers of isolated villages, nomads' tents with flocks of sheep, domesticated mountain goats and yaks grazing at the vast field.

Lake Mansarovar, an expanse of sparkling blue water sprawling over several miles, believed to be the seat of Brahma (the Creator of Universe) and the snow capped Mount Kailash is considered as the abode of Lord Shiva and his consort Parvati. The entire Kailash circuit trek is the holiest of all of Tibet's pilgrimages, an oasis of peace and serenity and the beacon that draws the many travelers to the western Tibet every year. It is said that a single circumference erases the accumulated sins of a lifetime while 108 circumferences achieve the Salvation or Nirvana.

Itinerary


Day 01: Arrival in Kathmandu and transfer to a Hotel.

On arrival in Kathmandu Airport, you would be met and received by our representative & transfer to the hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 02: Kathamandu Sightseeing Tour.

After breakfast, proceed for a city tour of Kathmandu visiting Durbar Square, a complex of palaces, courtyard and temples, built between the 12th and 18th centuries, used to be the seat of the ancient Malla kings of Kathmandu. In the afternoon visit the Swoyambunath Stupa and Patan City. Swoyambhunath Stupa, atop the hillock is one of the holiest Buddhist sites in Nepal enlisted in the World Heritage Site. Patan City is an enchanting melange of palace buildings, artistic courtyard and former palace complex. One remarkable monument here is a 16th century temple dedicated to the Hindu God Lord Krishna, built entirely of stone.

Day 03: Katmandu to Kerung (3700 mts. - 160kms.)



Day 04: Kerung to Tingri

Kerung to Tingri & free for excursion of Tingri city.

Day 05: Tingri to Dongba/ Paryang (4500mts. - 375kms)

After breakfast drive from Tingri to Dongba for about 08:00 hours. Overnight stay at Guesthouse.

Day 06: Dongba/Paryang (4500mts. - 335kms) to Mansarovar

After breakfast, drive from Dongba to Mansarovar 07:00 hours. Conducting Mansarovar Parikrama by vehicle. This is my first day staying at the bank of the Manasarovar Lake. This is the first day stay at the bank of the Manasarovar Lake, Overnight stay at the Guesthouse.

Day 07: Mansarovar to Darchen (4600mts. - 110kms.)

We will choose the special point to take a dip in Manasarovar Lake and conduct Pooja, hawan and spiritual activities according to your tradition. Drive around 2.30 hrs to Darchen and overnight stay at the Guesthouse. Ashtapad excursions can be done at extra cost.

Day 08: Darchen to Diraphuk (4890mts. - 12kms.)

This is the first day of Kailash Parikrama. We should start our journey after breakfast as early as possible. Today we will drive up to Yomawari and start walking continuously for about 6 to 7 hours. Horses can be hired at an extra cost for those who cannot walk. Yak will carry the kitchen utensils and equipment. Overnight stay at a mud house or tent on the basis of availability.

Day 09: Diraphuk to Zhulthulphuk (4790mts. - 22kms.)

This day is a bit of a complex journey and we have to pass Dolma-La Pass, which is 5400 meter in height, The weather is unpredictable in Dolma-la Pass and at any time a snowstorm can fall. So we try to start our journey as early as possible. On route we can have Darshan of Gaurikund but it is very difficult to go and touch. Overnight stay at a mud house or tent on the basis of availability.

Day 10: Zhulthulphuk to Paryang

We will Trek down to Darchen, catch our vehicle and Drive to Mansarovar to fill up spiritual jaal, later our tour starts back for Kathmandu following the same route and the same system applies for all subjects of our accommodation and meal Overnight stay at guesthouse in Paryang.

Day 11: Paryang to Nyalam

Drive back to Kerung, which is the last stay in Tibet part.

Day 12: Kerung to Katmandu

After custom formalities we will be picked up by Nepal side and continue drive to Kathmandu for about 05.00 hours and check in at Hotel

Day 13: Warm Deaparture

After Breakfast transfer to Airport for your flight to the next destination.
