# Kathmandu – Nagarkot sunrise Tour

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Kathmandu Nagarkot tour is one of the best historical, cultural and natural trip to Nepal. In Kathmandu we visit ancient palaces, stupas, temples and world famous heritage sites.

Our trip extends to the serene hill resort of Nagarkot where we witness a stunning radiant sunset as the sun drops to hide its glows between the mountains. Morning we see a spectacular sunrise as the sparkling rays of the sun can be seen breaking through the mountains in a myriad of maroon pink colors, a scene never to be forgotten.

When we return back to Kathmandu following Bhaktapur is a wonderful display of Nepal's golden age of the arts with its unique architecture.

### Itinerary

#### Day 01: Arrival in Kathmandu and transfer to a Hotel.

On arrival in Kathmandu Airport, you would be met and received by our representative & transfer to the hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

#### Day 02: Kathamandu Sightseeing Tour

After breakfast, proceed for a city tour of Kathmandu visiting Durbar Square, a complex of palaces, courtyard and temples, built between the 12th and 18th centuries, used to be the seat of the ancient Malla kings of Kathmandu. In the afternoon visit the Swoyambunath Stupa and Patan City. Swoyambhunath Stupa, atop the hillock is one of the holiest Buddhist sites in Nepal enlisted in the World Heritage Site. Patan City is an enchanting melange of palace buildings, artistic courtyard and former palace complex. One remarkable monument here is a 16th century temple dedicated to the Hindu God Lord Krishna, built entirely of stone.

#### Day 03: Kathmandu-Bhaktapur Sightseeing-Nagarkot (32 km 1& 1/2 hrs drive to Nagarkot)

After breakfast proceeds for the sightseeing of Pashupatinath temple, Boudhanath Stapa & Bhaktapur Durbar square. After breakfast, proceed for a city tour of Kathmandu visiting Pashupatinath and Boudhanath. Pashupatinath Temple is situated 5 km east of Kathmandu, the temple of Lord Shiva, Pashupatinath with two tiered golden roof and silver doors is considered one of the holiest shrines of Hindus. The stupa of Boudhanath lies 8kms east of Kathmandu. This ancient colossal stupa is one of the biggest in the world and the center of Buddhism in the world. It was listed in the UNESCO Heritage Monument in 1979. After Lunch we will visit Bhaktapur, the city of devotees. This town delivers sightseeing of medieval settlement with a number of cultural and historical squares, traditional skyscraper architectures and so on. Ancient Dattatraya temple, five storied Nyatapola temple, Pottery Square and of course, historical Durbar square are the eye-catching highlights of the town. After Bhaktapur sightseeing, drive to Nagarkot. Nagarkot is situated 32 km east of Kathmandu and at an altitude of 2175 m above sea level, Nagarkot is a popular destination

for the view of sunrise and sunset and panoramic view of Himalayas including Mount Everest.

### Day 04: Drive from Nagarkot-Kathmandu (32 km 1& 1/2 hrs drive)

Wake up early in the morning to enjoy the beautiful sunrise view from your room or from the terrace. After breakfast, we have some free time to enjoy a panoramic view of the Himalayas and a short trek. Later we will drive back to Kathmandu.

## Day 05: Warm Departure.

After Breakfast transfer to the airport for your next destination.
