

Koshi Tappu Wildlife Safari tour (4 Nights/ 5 Days)

Koshi Tappu Wildlife Reserve tour is a combined tour which is a blend of historical and wildlife safari tour which is the third popular wildlife safari tour in Nepal. Wildlife safari tour in Koshi tappu is an amazing experience of Nepal wildlife safari adventure trip.

Koshi Tappu Safari offers spectacular views of natural wilderness. Koshi Tappu wildlife safari tour is a popular safari destination located in eastern part of Nepal and one of the finest birding sites in Asia.

The Koshi Tappu Wildlife Reserve is situated on the flood plains of the Sapta-Koshi River in Eastern Nepal and covers 175 sq. km. The reserve is a wetland of international significance. In 1987, it was declared a Samsar site. It is home for more than 440 bird species, including 20 duck species, 2 species of ibises, many storks, egrets and herons.

Koshi tappu wildlife safari tour is a bird watcher's paradise. The Koshi Tappu wildlife reserve attracts a large number of migratory birds. It is the main habitat of Arna (wild water buffalo). Bird watchers arrive here in search of the beautiful Bengal florican and the flamboyant Sarus cranes.. Best season for Koshi Tappu jungle safari is from the beginning of March to the end of May and the beginning of September to the end of December. On a clear day, travelers can see the world's fifth highest mountain, Mt. Makalu 8463m .

Itinerary

Day 01: Arrival in the morning and brief introduction to the program

Ornithological Walk to see storks, ibises, snipes, water fowl, birds of prey etc. Evening slide show presentation on the Reserve's natural history followed by a Nepali dinner.

Day 02: Full Day Activities

Early breakfast. Full day's excursion by boat and 4 wheel drive (with packed lunch) to see waders, water fowl, birds of prey, marsh crocodiles, otters, wild water buffalo and Gangetic dolphins. (Includes a visit to the Pink Tower.) Evening program of traditional dance followed by BBQ meal.

Day 03: Full Day Activities

Breakfast. Bird watching in scrub forest, grasslands and wetlands habitats with packed lunch to see swamp partridges, black-necked storks, buntings, bulbuls, etc. Afternoon (either) continue bird watching (or) take an optional elephant ride to see Arna the wild water buffalo, blue bulls, hog deer, species of fish etc. Evening: stargazing followed by Chinese dinner.

Day 04: Full Day Activities

Breakfast. Full day's trip by four wheel drive to Chatara to see racket-tailed drongos, golden-backed woodpeckers, pied hornbills, leaf birds, red-thighed falconers etc. (packed lunch). Continental dinner.

Day 05: Sight Seeing and Departure

Bird watching around the camp or leisure time. Breakfast. Farewells and departure.
