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Day 11: Dira Phuk – Zutul Phuk (4,750m) 20km. O/N at Camp.
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Day 12: Zutul Phuk - Darchen (14km) - drives to Mamas rover-Pinchung (4,330m) 60km. O/N Camp Zutul Phuk - Darchen (14km) - drives to Mamas rover-Pinchung (4,330m) 60km. O/N Camp.
